


Title/Subject: Community Alerts
Serial No: DP0091
Summary: This decision paper relates to whether the PCC should join the West Yorkshire Community Alerts system. We have been made aware of a new community messaging system for the public in West Yorkshire. Members of the public register on the system (https://www.wypcommunityalert.co.uk/) and can choose to receive news and appeals, local crime information and/or prevention advice direct to them by email, text or voice message. Registering is completely free to members of the public and once they have signed-up, they can choose what they want to receive messages about. If the PCC were to join it would enable greater communication with West Yorkshire communities supporting the outcomes and priorities in the Police and Crime Plan.
Requested Decision: That the PCC purchases a license to enable the use the Community Alerts system.
