







<b>Title/Subject:</b> Funding for Independent Domestic Violence Advisors (IDVA) provision to Community Safety Partnerships.
<b>Reference:</b> Victim, Witness and Criminal Justice Delivery Fund (MoJ) 2017-18
<b>Executive Summary:</b> Supporting victims and witnesses is an outcome within the Police and Crime Plan and both sexual and domestic abuse are priorities over the next five years. Independent Domestic Abuse Advisors (IDVAs) provide valuable support to victims of domestic abuse to enable them to take their case to court and provide practical and emotional support.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> The PCC provides the same level of financial support £25,000 (total £125,000) for IDVA provision to each of the five Community Safety Partnerships in West Yorkshire for 2017-18.
