


Title/Subject: CSP delivery of support services for young victims and/or victims of hate crime.
Reference:
Executive Summary: Working closely with the five Community Safety Partnerships is recognised as a strength in ensuring the needs of people in West Yorkshire are responded to locally. For the current year there remains a small balance of funding within the victim services grant from the Ministry of Justice; there are also two key priority areas which need a response, supporting young victims and victims of hate crime. Each district have been approached to identify how they could achieve delivery of services before the end of the financial year. An indicative budget of £20,000 for each area of support was offered to each CSP which equates to £40,000 per district
Requested Decision: That the PCC agrees to fund each of the five Community Safety Partnerships to enable them to provide support services to victims of hate crime and young victims of crime.
