







Title/Subject: Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) Innovation Fund 2
Reference:
Executive Summary: In December 2014 the West Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC) Partnership Executive Group (PEG) Innovation sub-group made a series of proposals to address issues in relation to Child sexual Exploitation which had been identified by the West Yorkshire Directors of Children's Services (DCS's) and the West Yorkshire CSE Strategy Group. This project was delivered through a grant agreement with Calderdale Council
The grant agreement and proposal allocated £385k for year 1 and £297k for year 2. Part of the grant agreement was to provide support for victims of CSE.
Requested Decision: The West Yorkshire OPCC approves the recommendations in the supporting paper to explore the potential development of specialist Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) foster care provision in West Yorkshire. The funding will provide for the recruitment of a development post to explore and develop these concepts further. The cost estimated cost of this development post is £35,900.
