



Title/Subject: Extension of Hope for Justice Seconded contract
Reference:
Executive Summary: In May 2016 an employee of Hope for Justice a registered charity was seconded into the OPCC to support the OPCC in ensuring the effective delivery of the National Anti-Trafficking and Modern Slavery Network and raising awareness of the priority. This work has made significant impact in its objective of raising the profile and awareness of Human Trafficking and modern slavery locally, regionally, nationally and internationally and this has been recognised by many key stakeholders including the Independent Anti-Slavery Commissioner, the National Police Chiefs Council, the Gangmasters Licensing Authority and the Home Office amongst others. This success has also drawn an increased demand on the resources of the OPCC not only from the aforementioned key stakeholders but also, NGO's, Academia, Community Groups, and other police areas, again this demand has been local, national and international. This not only reflects the importance and innovation of the work being done but also the nature and scale of human trafficking and modern slavery.
Requested Decision: That due to the success and increased demand the PCC extends the hours of secondment of the Hope for Justice employee within the OPCC to 15 hours per week. This will enable the continued delivery of raising awareness of Human Trafficking and Modern Slavery, support the vital work of the National Anti-Trafficking and Modern Slavery Network and build resilience of partners through shared learning, consequently reducing the harm to victims of trafficking and slavery, making all communities safer.
