





Record of decision made by the Police and Crime Commissioner

Title/Subject: Proposal to support the Leeds Police Control Room pilot project developed in partnership with Leeds and York Partnership Foundation Trust and West Yorkshire Police.
Reference:
Executive Summary: The proposal is to extend the service for a further year to continue with the partnership and work through the West Yorkshire Urgent & Emergency Care Vanguard. The Vanguard aims to improve, coordinate and streamline the urgent response for Police working with vulnerable people and a single operating model is to be rolled out across West Yorkshire.
Requested Decision: To provide a second year's funding to the Leeds Police Control Room pilot, totalling £77,132.50, from the PEG Innovation Fund; that is 50% of the total cost. The remaining 50% will be provided by the NHS.
