Title/Subject: Partnership Executive Group: Community Safety Fund Improved resettlement of young people in custody with through the gate services
Reference:
Executive Summary: The consortium is seeking to continue a pilot involving a link officer professional and a voluntary sector mentoring service to provide input in custody (a window for change), through the gate and in the community. The current pilot would be further developed to improve further the resettlement transition. It is proposed it could be funded in collaboration between the West Yorkshire PCC (through the Partnership Executive Group Innovation Fund), HMYOI Wetherby and South Yorkshire PCC. Link Officer: £27,057 (contribution from West Yorkshire) The aim of the role is to provide all West and South Yorkshire YOTs and Wetherby Young Offenders Institute (YOI) with a continuing in-custody contact who will work closely with Wetherby staff and YOT staff to provide support and interventions to young people. Mentoring Service: £33,750 (contribution from West Yorkshire) The link officer does not have the capacity to provide the intensity of mentoring support necessary to support resettlement and reduce re-offending and victimisation. They therefore work in partnership with In2Out, a not-for-profit organisation, who provide mentoring service using volunteers.
Requested Decision: That the PCC provides a contribution to funding to support the link officer and mentoring services to improve resettlement outcomes for one year until 30 June 2017.
