





Record of Decision made by the Police and Crime Commissioner

Title/Subject: Chief Officer post-employment notification
Serial No: DP0079
Summary: The Home Office has introduced a notification system whereby Chief Officer's appointed after 1 January 2018 must seek approval of the PCC (for Chief Constables) and the Chief Constable (for other Chief Officers) for any post-employment service (paid or unpaid) during the 12 months after leaving the police service. The notification obligations may be adopted by current Chief Officers on a voluntary basis.
Requested Decision: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. That the PCC notes the Home Office advice to require post-employment notification from any Chief Officers appointed after 1 January 2018.2. That the PCC invites the present Chief Constable to voluntarily adopt the new post-employment notification arrangements proposed by the Home Office.3. That, if the new notification arrangements are adopted by the present Chief Constable, their contract is amended accordingly.
