


**Record of decision made by the Police and Crime Commissioner**

<b>Title/Subject:</b> Mental Health Professionals in WYP Leeds District Control Room (DCR)
<b>Reference:</b> PCC Innovation Fund 2017-18
<b>Executive Summary:</b> There is a need to provide mental health nurses in police district control rooms. It assists in the early identification of mental health needs, improving outcomes for service users and better management of risk, ensuring an early diversion to the most appropriate pathway for the individual. The PCC is committed to working with partners to ensure this happens, the request is also supported by the PCC's Criminal Justice and Mental Health Forum.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> The PCC is asked to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Provide £57,181 in 2017-18 to cover the period from 1 May 2017 to 31 March 2018, the PCC providing 50% of the funding with Safer Leeds providing the additional 50%.</li> <li>b) Thereafter meet one third of the costs for three years from 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2021, which will be £38,166 per annum, this to be one third of the costs shared by Safer Leeds, the PCC and Leeds North CCG.</li> </ul>
